Nation Mourns for Monarch, 92; Son, 67, Takes Over Throne

STOCKHOLM - King Gustaf V of Sweden, Europe's oldest reigning monarch, died at Drottningholm Palace Sunday at the age of 92.

All Sweden was plunged into mourning as the monarch's peaceful reign of nearly 43 years ended.

With his death, his oldest son, Crown Prince Gustaf Adolf, 67 became Sweden's new king.
