VERMONTVILLE METHODIST CHURCH PASTORS 1859-1932

Vermontville Methodist Church in its pioneer days, was connected with Eaton Circuit. It stood on the point of land just east of the Brown school house. Fifty-five years ago this month, September, 1877, it was moved into the Village.
