Local Man, Financial Expert, Dies

James Harvey, 62, Lansing, a nationally recognized expert on Credit Unions, died of a heart attack Thursday evening in the Kellogg Center.

Mr. Harvey collapsed following the International Credit Union Day dinner meeting. He was pronounced dead at the scene.

Mr. Harvey was the treasurer-

manager of the Motor Wheel Credit Union. He helped to organize the credit union in 1936 and had served as its manager ever since.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

He gained national recognition while serving six years as the Michigan representative on the Credit Union National Association board.

He also served several years on the Michigan Credit Union League board and had held every office in the Lansing Chapter of Credit Unions.

In 1956 he was named the "Credit Union Man of the Year" by the Lansing chapter.

A native of Scotland, Mr. Harvey came to Lansing in 1920. A professional fighter in his youth, he was the Michigan flyweight champion in the early 20s.
