Clare S. Kirtland was born September 12, 1894 in Lakeview, Mich., the son of Addison and Laura (Stebbins) Kirtland. He was a graduate pharmacist from Ferris Institute. Mr. Kirtland owned and operated a drug store here for 16 years. On July 2, 1913 he was united in marriage to Miss Losia Bass at Grand Rapids. He was a World War I veteran, a member of the Sunfield F. & A. M. Lodge 455, and the Consistory at Grand Rapids.
