HENRY MARTIN, SR. BURIED FROM CHARLOTTE THIS WEEK

Funeral services were held this week from the Burkhead-Cheney funeral home in Charlotte for Henry M. Martin, well known Windsor township farmer, who died last Saturday at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Allen (Beulah) Houghton of Route 3, Lake Odessa, with whom he had lived for the past five years.

Mr. Martin is remembered as probably the most active solicitor in the drive to raise funds for the Hayes-Green-Beech modern hospital opened for use in late 1954.

He was born in Odessa township of Ionia county, son of William and Emily (Stillman) Martin. He was married July 15, 1906, in Lansing to Zella Rowlander, and was a member of the Charlotte United Brethren church.
