

## Florence B. Vandecar Passes Away

Florence B. Vandecar passed away at the home of her daughter and son-in-law Mr. and Mrs. Arden McLaughlin, at the age of 81. She had been ill for about six weeks.

Mrs. Vandecar was born in Odessa Township, Ionia County, February 8, 1881, the first of ten children born to George and Martha Downer Clark. She graduated from Lake Odessa High School in 1899, one of two graduates that year. She was united in marriage to Lewis H. Vandecar on December 25th, 1902.
