John A. Campbell Services Held Monday

Funeral services were held Monday afternoon from the Mapes Funeral Home for John A. Campbell, 79, local businessman, who passed away suddenly Thursday evening, April 19, at the home of his daughter-in-law, Mrs. Ethel Campbell, of Washington Street.

Mrs. Campbell was in partnership with his son Charles, who died in 1955, in a combination gas station, insurance agency and blacksmith shop, a business he owned since 1927. At one time he operated a Ford agency in Sunfield. Previously Mr. Campbell was a proprietor of a jewelry store in Portland.

Mr. Campbell was born in Sebawa township, Ionia County, on June 29, 1876, the son of Edward and Seneth Campbell. He spent all his life in this area. Mr. Campbell was a member of the Sunfield Lodge No. 455 F. & A. M.
