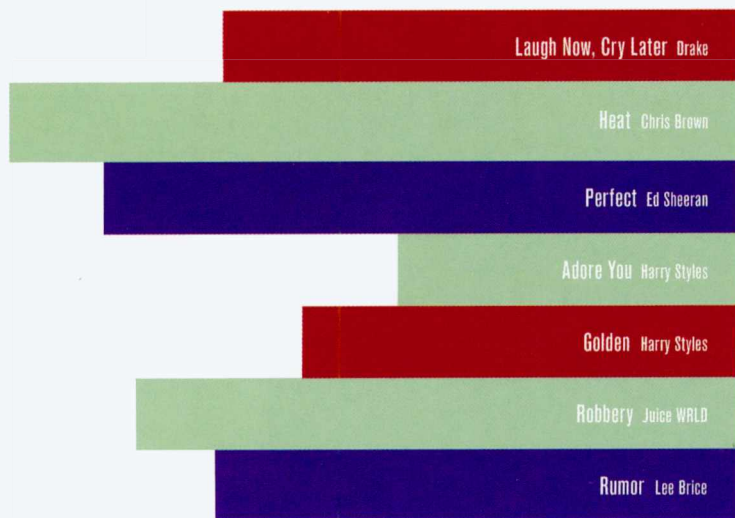
When we gather on the dance floor

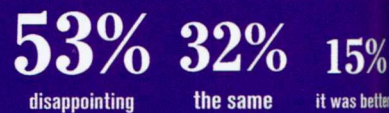
