

75TH ANNIVERSARY -1913

Feb. 28th being the 75th anniversary of the organization of the Church, it was decided to observe the occasion in suitable manner. Therefore on the 27th a banquet was served at the chapel. After dinner Mr. Dalzell acting as toastmaster called on several for reminiscences. A special service was also arranged for Sunday March 2nd, but owing to the inclemency of the weather it was postponed until Mar. 16th when a very interesting service was held both morning and evening. At the morning service special music was rendered a score or so of letters from absent ones who had formerly been associated with the church were read, after which a very able sermon was delivered by W.H. Sutherland, D.D. of Lansing. The evening service consisted of a special praise service, followed by a brief but interesting address by Dr. Sutherland. This was followed by a special rededication service in which the entire church took part. The Pastor (Mr. Dalzell) was absent from the services of the day on account of the serious illness of his wife.
