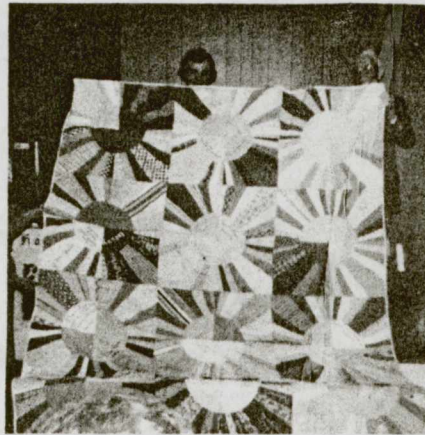


## Vermontville Church Has Many Activities
